

#### LIBYA: WORKSHOP ON ITALIAN LEGAL TERMINOLOGY

(ANSAmEd) - TRIPOLI, NOVEMBER 3 - A better knowledge of the Italian language will increase trade between Italy and Libya. With this idea in mind, the workshop 'Introduction into legal terminology' has been organised for Libyan students with a degree in the Italian language. The workshop - which started this morning and will continue until November 5 - is part of the activities of the Italian Department of the Academy of Advanced Studies in Tripoli. The course is taught by lawyers Paolo Greco and Lorenzo Ascanio, experts in Libyan commercial law. Around 40 civil servants and employees of private companies participate in the workshop. The course is divided in three parts: introductions into legal terminology, commercial law and drawing up contracts.
